1. **Starting date of the project and end date (if completed)**
2003

2. **Target group**

1) (Ex-)users and survivors of psychiatry and people threatened by unwanted psychiatric treatment; 2) supporters of (ex-)users and survivors of psychiatry

3. **Aims of the project**

- a) Training from a user/survivor perspective, provided by people with experiences in self-help and alternatives to the psychiatric system for over two decades.
- b) Setting up of the Advice-Information-Selfhelp-Centre, development and accompany new offers of services and facilities for (ex-) users and survivors of psychiatry, combined with a board of appeal for complaints about discrimination and harassment based on psychiatric diagnoses
- c) User-controlled research

4. **Settings of the project**

The settings vary, it can take place in the room of the organisation or in institutions.

5. **Is the project carried out on a national, regional or local level ?**

In Any Case is based in the centre of the Bundesland and city of Berlin, but is being carried out at local, regional, national & international level.

6. **How was the project financed?**

Supported by donations of welfare organisations, but not yet supported by the German government or regional administration.

7. **Has the project been evaluated (internally/externally)?**

Not yet.

8. **Were (ex-)users and survivors of psychiatry involved in the project ?**

Controlled by (ex-)users and survivors of psychiatry. One person without own experiences in the psychiatric system is involved (a former psychiatric male nurse)
